Appearance

The proposed extension's external walls are covered in white render, while the roof construction is a standing seam roof. Finally, the double-glazed windows, are imitating and keeping the rhythm of the original ones on the existing building. This specific selection of materials was chosen to contrast with the existing building's traditional character, without compromising the context of the surrounding buildings.

Access

Pedestrian access is preserved at the south-west side of the site. At the moment, the existing entrance is used as the main access for the visitors, personnel and students. Four steps are leading to the children's main entrance in combination with a mechanical operated platform. The new levelling ramps will give level access to all, creating a better movement, and fully independent from the existing mechanical means, which will no longer be needed.
