Job Description: Mainscale Teacher

Job Purpose

To teach pupils within the primary age range, 4 - 11.

Responsibilities

1. Teaching Duties

- create a stimulating learning environment
- prepare, teach, review and evaluate all aspects of the curriculum you deliver.
- take into account the different learning styles and needs of your pupils,
- assess, record and report on the development, progress and attainment of pupils
- promote the general progress and well-being of all pupils
- maintain good order and discipline among pupils and safeguard their health and safety
- communicate and consult with the parents of the pupils
- use ICT effectively to deliver the curriculum and support children's learning

2. Other Professional Duties

- participate in the Performance Management process
- review when necessary your methods of teaching and programmes of work
- attend and fully participate in staff, planning and phase meetings
- engage in continued professional development
- advise and co-operate with colleagues on the preparation and development of courses of study, teaching programmes, methods of teaching and assessment and pastoral arrangements

3. Curriculum Responsibility

- To take on the role of subject leader for an area of the curriculum to be agreed.
- This will involve relevant training, leading development of the subject and monitoring its delivery and standards throughout the school.

You are required to undertake any other reasonable duties as detailed by the Headteacher. All duties are to be undertaken in relation to school policies, curriculum documentation and the School Improvement Plan.

Statutory Requirements

You are required to carry out the duties of a school teacher as set out in the current School Teacher's Pay and Conditions document.
